I have been in correspondence with the various owners of 19 Wadham Gdns for the past 24 years regarding their neglect to pollard the boundary poplars T11-15. They have been causing problems to other neighbours too during all those years of neglect. You will see from the Camden records 2010 - 125 King Henry's Rd took off overhanging limbs 2017 - I took off overhanging limb on T15 2019 - 121 King Henry's Rd took off overhanging limb and ivy 2020 - I took off overhanging limb on T15 Tom Little visited me in 2019 and confirmed the poplars were dangerously overgrown since original pollarding in 2001 but being on private land, outside of his remit to take action. I am relieved that the new owners have applied to carry out long overdue maintenance on all the trees. I hope that reducing T15 to original pollard points will be sufficient for the tree to no longer present a risk to my own boundary walls and indeed my garden that I have had to relandscape as it was no longer "mediterranean" having lost all sunlight. I would appreciate it if the tree officer viewed the trees from my property when he visits 19 Wadham Gardens. Normally I am trying to save local trees!

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
