Currently the joint garden of numbers 1 and 1A Fawley Road is bordered by high fencing and walls which make the garden a very peaceful and quiet place. There is no noise from any source, not even the nearby roads. This means that the garden is an ideal place for quiet thinking and reading undisturbed. However, that could change dramatically with a roof terrace overlooking it which is what the proposals would produce. Noise could then come from eating, drinking and loud conversation, possibly even from groups of people or parties. This would be a gross infringement and destroy a much treasured and much loved amenity. 2. The roof terrace would overlook the window of my sitting room, meaning I would need to draw my blind to maintain privacy. 3.
