I am attaching the comments from the Bloomsbury CAAC on this application.

We are amazed that this application appears to have been granted already:

1. when the application was only registered on 10 September
2. since it seems to grant consent for illuminated signs when this is within the Bloomsbury CA where internally illuminated signs are not permitted
3. when it and a previous version were not shown to us in the Bloomsbury CAAC.

And must point out in addition that:

4. the Caffè Nero signage is not included in the application but has already been erected
5. more seriously, an additional plastic storey has been added to the electricity substation at the rear of the building, blocking views of the architecture of Woburn Walk, and when this extra storey does not have consent (it is not included in the application 2023/3680/P)
