This s.211 notification is to remove a Cherry tree (T1) growing in the rear garden of a private residence on Camden Road, which is within the Camden Square Conservation Area. The proposed removal is due to the tree being structurally compromised with an area of decay in the stem on the underside of a significant lean.

Regrettably a replacement tree cannot be conditioned under a s.211 notification.

Due to the increased risk of failure of the tree, it is not expedient to serve a TPO to protect it.

The Council does not object to the proposed works.
