Proposal: Amalgamation of two flats to create a single dwellinghouse (C3) and enclosure of space below front entrance steps.

Drawing Nos: CS010-E001; CS030-D001; CS030-P001; CS030-P900; Site Location Plan, 28 Aug 2024; Design, Access, Heritage Statement, 28th August 2024.

The Council has considered your application and decided to grant permission subject to the following condition(s):

Condition(s) and Reason(s):

1 The development hereby permitted must be begun not later than the end of three years from the date of this permission.

Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).

2 The development hereby permitted shall be carried out in accordance with the following approved plans CS010-E001; CS030-D001; CS030-P001; CS030-P000; Site Location Plan, 28 Aug 2024; Design, Access, Heritage Statement,

28th August 2024.

Reason: For the avoidance of doubt and in the interest of proper planning.

3 All new external work shall be carried out in materials that resemble, as closely as possible, in colour and texture those of the existing building, unless otherwise specified in the approved application.

Reason: To safeguard the appearance of the premises and the character of the immediate area in accordance with the requirements of policy D1 and D2 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.

Informative(s):

1 Reasons for granting permission.

The application site comprises a Grade II listed terraced house, which is a positive contributor within the Bloomsbury Conservation Area.

The applicant is seeking permission for the amalgamation of two self-contained flats into a single dwellinghouse (Class C3) and enclosure of the space below the front entrance steps.

The amalgamation of two existing flats would lead to the loss of one home which is considered acceptable in accordance with policy H3 of the Camden Local Plan 2017 which only resists the loss of two or more homes.

The enclosure of the area under the front steps is considered acceptable in this instance given that houses on this side of Calthorpe Road already have half-enclosed under step areas, and the proposed design is considered sympathetic to the character of a Victorian basement.

Special attention has been paid to the desirability of preserving or enhancing the listed building, its setting and its features of special architectural or historic interest, and the character or appearance of the Conservation Area, under s.66 and s.72 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990 as amended by the Enterprise and Regulatory Reform Act 2013.

Given the scale and nature of proposed works, the proposal would not give rise to any adverse amenity related effects.

No objections were received following statutory consultation. The site's planning history has been taken into account when making this decision.

As such, the proposed development is in general accordance with policies A1, D1, D2 and H3 of the Camden Local Plan 2017. The proposed development also accords with the London Plan 2021 and the National Planning Policy Framework 2023.

2 Your proposals may be subject to control under the Building Regulations and/or the London Buildings Acts that cover aspects including fire and emergency escape, access and facilities for people with disabilities and sound insulation between dwellings. You are advised to consult the Council's Building Control Service, Camden Town Hall, Judd St, Kings Cross, London NW1 2QS (tel: 020-7974 6941).

- 3 This approval does not authorise the use of the public highway. Any requirement to use the public highway, such as for hoardings, temporary road closures and suspension of parking bays, will be subject to approval of relevant licence from the Council's Streetworks Authorisations & Compliance Team, 5 Pancras Square c/o Town Hall, Judd Street London WC1H 9JE (Tel. No 020 7974 4444). Licences and authorisations need to be sought in advance of proposed works. Where development is subject to a Construction Management Plan (through a requirement in a S106 agreement), no licence or authorisation will be granted until the Construction Management Plan is approved by the Council.

Noise from demolition and construction works is subject to control under the Control of Pollution Act 1974. You must carry out any building works that can be heard at the boundary of the site only between 08.00 and 18.00 hours Monday to Friday and 08.00 to 13.00 on Saturday and not at all on Sundays and Public Holidays. You must secure the approval of the Council's Noise and Licensing Enforcement Team prior to undertaking such activities outside these hours.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraph 38 of the National Planning Policy Framework 2023.
