OBJECTION

The applicant states that the purpose of the "pergola" is to shade from afternoon sun. Suitable shading could be provided on the fully glazed rear elevations with simple louvres. The existing extension is built with large roof lights where it does not seem that shading was deemed to have been necessary. The form of these structures is not like a garden "pergola". They are heavyweight, volumetric structures which are not subservient to the existing extensions. The perceived volume is approximately a third again of the size of the permitted extensions and our view is that they affect the amenity of adjacent properties, blocking light and views. These structures should not have been built before seeking Planning Consent."
