1 Reasons for granting:

Condition 3 of planning permission ref 2023/3595/P granted on 8/03/2024 requires evidence to be submitted that shows that at least 95% of the waste generated from demolition should be diverted away from landfill.

The applicant has submitted a site waste management strategy to show that 100% of the materials, primarily concrete, from the car park have been recycled and thus diverted away from landfill in accordance with the

requirements of the condition.

The full impact of the proposed development has already been assessed. The proposed details would contribute to reducing waste and supporting the circular economy.

As such, the proposed details are in general accordance with policy CC1 of the Camden Local Plan 2017.
