I also do not want access for any more cars seeing that the one car he has, is repeatedly and seemingly permanently parked on my drive, as opposed to on his forecourt, which he has blocked and made the area into some sort of private front garden!</p> <p>With the increased size of house, this will more likely increase the need for more cars too. I refuse to let any other vehicles cross my land and therefore all access will have to be obtained via the heath.</p> <p>Works have been going on and are still ongoing, at the Lodge and his workmen have been very aggressive, rude and non cooperative with myself as the owner of the land, to the point I have felt very threatened and intimidated to interact with them and on one occasion had been ordered to return to my home. Not to mention the total lack of consideration of the mess left on a daily basis. I could not communicate these issues with Mr Chaumet as he travels a lot abroad with work.</p> <p>These factors do add up, hence my reluctance to all the building works being proposed.</p> <p>But the main issue still being my views of the Heath being obscured.</p>

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
