The Council has considered your application dated 28 August 2024 and decided to refuse consent for the following reason(s):

## Reason(s) for Refusal

The TPO was served as the evidence intially provided for the s211 notification was not considered robust enough - no root samples taken from the trial pit and borehole were identified as Acer roots, therefore the evidence submitted was not sufficient to attribute this to the Acer: it did not demonstrate that on the balance of probabilities the Acer is contributing to the damage.

No further evidence has been submitted to address this issue. On this basis it is recommended that the works be refused.
