Dear Mr Vincent, dear Planning Committee and Supporting Communities Directorate,

In light of the support submission from A and L Potter yesterday I need to write again, the Council must not be caused to proceed on the wrong basis as to the facts:

The Cypress tree in the rear garden at 40 Frognal does not impact on gardens at 44 or 46 Frognal (too far away), it produces no blight in any garden whatsoever, it has not damaged any other trees nor caused any dead branches, there is no danger to life or property connected to this tree. The Council will note that neither the applicant nor the Potters made any such suggestion during their comprehensive prior submissions regarding the 9 July 2024 application to for felling 1 and reducing 3 trees (ref 2024/2757/T) at 40 Frognal.

The Potters who are driving this application have a large garden at 42 Frognal with ample sunshine (see attached photo: there is no blight). Their wish never to have any shade from any trees next door must not allow the very serious diminution of the last remaining evergreen habitat for wild life, nor of the precious tree cover in a Conservation Area enjoyed by all the nearby residents of Frognal and Netherhall Gardens. They have not addressed these points at all.
