I wish to object strongly to the proposal to remove two substantial mature trees at Cecil House 102-104 Albert Street NW1 7NE.

It seems the work is being driven by insurance company priorities rather than townscape, and environmental biodiversity reasons.

The movement/growth of tree routes can be controlled with careful pollarding which allows the tree to be retained. Root damage/costs are important to a charity but the removal of two substantial trees far outweighs these factors particularly when alternative pruning techniques are available.
