**NO OBJECTION TO SECTION 211 NOTICE OF WORKS TO TREE/S IN A

Proposed Work:
FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Ash (T1) - Crown reduce height and spread back to previous reduction points leaving soft furnishing growth (approx. 5m height and 3.5m spread).
1 x Elm (T2) - Crown reduce height by 5m. Crown reduce spread to balance and shape (approx. 3m). Crown reduce low limb over road back in line with brick wall.
1 x Ash (T3) - Crown reduce height and spread back to previous reduction points leaving soft furnishing growth (approx. 5m height and 3.5m spread).
SIDE GARDEN: 1 x Ash (T4) - Fell to ground level.
1 x Ash (T5) - Fell to ground level.
REAR GARDEN: 1 x Ash (T8) - Reduce crown spread towards church by 4m.
1 x Holly (T9) - Crown reduce spread growing towards church back to stem. back to previous reduction points leaving soft furnishing growth (approx. 5m height and 3.5m spread). Crown reduce remainder back to previous reducing points (approx. 4m height and 1m spread).
Mixed Saplings (G1) - Reduce group of saplings by an additional 40% - 50% respectively, (approx. 4m height and 2m spread).

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 30 September 2024 and does not wish to object.

- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, whichever is the sooner.
- 2 You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by the Council.
- 3 Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife.
