- 1 The application seeks the discharge of condition 4 of listed building consent application 2024/1096/L relating to doors, which reads as follows:

Detailed drawings in respect of the following, shall be submitted to and

approved in writing by the local planning authority before the relevant part of the work is begun:

Plan, elevation and section drawings of all new external doors at a scale of 1:10 with typical moulding and architrave details at a scale of 1:1.

Details of the external door have been submitted and are acceptable.

The proposed works will not harm the special interest of the grade-II\*-listed building.

The site's planning history has been taken into account in making this decision.

Special attention has been paid to the desirability of preserving the special interest of the listed building, under s.16 of the Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas Act 1990 as amended by the Enterprise and Regulatory Reform Act (ERR) 2013

As such, the proposal is in general accordance with policy D2 of the Camden Local Plan 2017. The proposed development also accords with the London Plan 2021 and the NPPF.

- 2 You are advised that all conditions relating to listed building consent 2024/1096/L which need details to be submitted, have been approved.
