1 Reasons for granting permission/consent-

This application is to discharge parts C of condition 11 regarding land contamination. Parts A and B of condition 11 have been discharged and approved under application reference 2021/5877/P.

The contamination land team have reviewed the submitted documents and the

additional topsoil results. Overall they indicate the material is chemically suitable for use within the soft landscaped areas and therefore point C (and condition 11) can be fully discharged.

The planning history of the site was taken into account when coming to this decision.

As such, the proposed development is in general accordance with policies A1 and DM1 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.
