Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Lime (T1) - Reduce overall crown by up to 2.5m - 3m branch lengths within previous reduction framework. Reduce away from property to provide minimum 2m clearance. Maintain natural and even flowing canopy outline. Remove epicormic growth, crossing branches and any defective branch wood.

1 x Lime (T2) - Fell to ground level.

1 x Lime (T3) - Re-pollard back to previous reduction points. Remove any defective branch wood.

1 x Yew (T4) - Reduce width by up to 2m retaining natural form.

1 x Crab Apple (T5) - Reduce overall crown by up to 1.5m branch lengths within previous reduction framework. Maintain natural and even flowing canopy outline. Remove epicormic growth, crossing branches and any defective branch wood.

1 x Holly (T6) - Reduce lateral spread over garden by up to 2m.

1 x Crab Apple (T7) - Reduce overall crown by up to 2.5m - 3m branch lengths within previous reduction framework. Maintain natural and even flowing canopy outline. Remove lower lateral branches over pathway. Remove epicormic growth, crossing branches and any defective branch wood.

1 x Conifer (T8) - Fell to ground level.

2 x Elders (T9 & T10) - Crown reduce footpath by 3m - 4m.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 04 November 2024 and does not wish to object.
