I am one of the owners of 176 Camden Road, and am writing to strongly suggest that this work does not continue. We have strong subsidence issues in the area. A property on this road did the same, and it caused £200,000 subsidence damage. Further to this potential damage, 178 have already felled trees and plants in the back garden which were enjoyed by all properties surrounding, without replacing and now the garden is just a concrete paved block covered in weeds.

Of course, if 178 would like to trim it back that is fine, but it is both unnecessary and completely unreasonable regarding the risks of subsidence to fell the tree completely.

Due to the extremely, potentially life ruining costs of such damage, I plead the reasonableness of this work be contemplated before permission is granted.
