In both the Design and Access Statement and the Heritage Impact Assessment great emphasis is put on the original design features of William Willett's original garden suburb, the reason for Conservation Area designation in 1973

William Willett laid out his suburb with roads lined by plane trees and the house boundaries of privet hedges. The privet hedge at this address was removed by the hoarding and during construction work. It was the original. Rather than introducing beech, Fagus sylvatica, which is not evergreen, there is an opportunity to reintroduce the original privet feature.
