Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposed shopfront alterations, installation of an awning and proposed fascia sign, by reason of the detailed design, use of materials, inappropriate illumination and loss of original architectural features, are considered to be out of character with the host Grade II listed building and therefore, causes detrimental harm to its appearance and significance, contrary to Policy D2 (Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.
