I consider it most important that the proposed modifications to the service bay at 1 Museum Street are considered by the whole Planning Committee. The idea that all the rubbish from the development should be bagged and placed on the public pavement is a decidedly retrograde step. There is no talk of segregation at a time when insufficient waste is already being recycled and, apart from the rats and mice, our area of Covent Garden is currently plagued by very aggressive and insistent crows - even the gulls fear them. The proposals for two lifts to deal with both deliveries and the removal of waste was far preferable, should be tabled again and fully considered.
