The BCAAC looked at this application in some detail and object in the strongest terms. The BCAAC also looked at historic photos of this property noticing the damage that has been done to its facade. This gas riser should be placed internally or within the wall, not left on the outside, in touching distance to passers-by using the footpath. This property is next to the historic Yorkshire Grey Pub and this external gas pipe, virtually on the footpath, is completely unacceptable. The door way has been badly altered by this gas pipe on the right side of the door. Moreover, the facade should be reinstated to its original symmetry with the gas pipe being moved off the outside. This is without question no place for a gas riser.
