2024/5627/P	The Belsize Society	07/01/2025 23:24:33	COMMNT	<p>We must assume the replacement double glazed windows are wooden framed though this is not mentioned (just states 'matching') and the drawings are not definitive on this. The large glazed window at ground floor level is a rather incongruous element disrupting the rear extension and we would prefer it to be subdivided. Likewise the ground floor 'Crittall' french doors would be better with external glazing bars (it appears they are within the glass) and better in wood than metal to maintain the style and rhythm of the rear elevation. Replacing the roof level french doors would have been a good opportunity to add glazing bars to improve the appearance.</p>
