To Whom It May Concern,

I am writing to formally object to the proposed opening of an off-licence at the above location. As a resident of Agar Grove, I have significant concerns about the impact this development will have on our community.

The addition of an off-licence is likely to attract late-night loiterers, intoxicated individuals, and potential disturbances, which could negatively affect the safety and well-being of local residents. The initial vision for the development was to enhance the residential nature of Agar Grove, and I believe that this proposal is inconsistent with that goal.

Furthermore, there is already a NISA Local conveniently located approximately 30 meters from the proposed site. The need for another off-licence in such close proximity is unclear and appears redundant. When this development was under construction, we were under the impression that the space would be utilized for offices or a facility that would provide tangible benefits to the community.

I urge you to reconsider this proposal in light of these concerns and the potential adverse effects on the residential character of the area.
