The proposed felling of even one elm tree (T9) is worrying, as these trees provide unique ecological benefits and are culturally significant.  Similarly, ash trees play a crucial role in our biodiversity and have faced significant threats in recent years, particularly from ash dieback disease. The proposal to fell three ash trees (T22, T24 & T25) is concerning, given their importance to our ecosystem.
