I strongly object.

Waldon's continuous disregard for the valid arguments and complaints against the installation from Crestview residents, immediate neighbours, the local community, Historic England, St Mary's Church and Camden Planning's is deeply concerning and upsetting.

Crestview is a small residential property. Each flat has a balcony and the building would be subjected to daily intolerable humming, buzzing and vibrations emitted by the proposed rooftop cabinets, increased mass of railings, taller antennae, ladders and cables. Waldon clearly affords no importance to the wellbeing and quality of the daily lives of the residents. They claim they are replacing existing satellite dishes & aerial antennae but there has never been any on the roof since they first applied for planning permission. It will completely dominate and dwarf the building as the height of the proposed antennae is almost a third of the building.

Importantly, Crestview sits opposite an English Heritage listed building – St Mary's Brookfield. The proposed installation's highly visual appearance will blight the views from the church and have a devastatingly negative and intrusive impact on this conservation area and the surroundings far and wide. It goes against the Dartmouth Park Conservation and Historic England principles.

Waldon's arguments against using more suitable buildings for the proposed installations seem weak and no real justification for discounting the many nearby suitable public buildings for this installation.

We would urge you **not** to approval this application.
