This application was discussed at the most recent Bloomsbury CAAC meeting.

Roofscape is an important element of a heritage neighbourhood and the proposed proliferation of aerials and digital equipment on this host building will cause harm to the Conservation Area. Oxford Street presents a unique and varied roofscape to those that pass by, when they look up beyond the ground floor - which many people do, because of the fine architecture on higher levels. They may also admire the Christmas lights which adorn the street in winter, and they do not wish their skyward view to be blighted by digital mobile telephone equipment on the rooftop of this building.

We object to the proposal to install 6 antennas, 2 transmission dishes, a cabinet and other ancillary equipment on the roof top of 100 Oxford Street. Please refuse the application.
