Removal down to ground level of one Portugal laurel bush referenced as T2-C1 and one Cherry Laurel reference as T3-C1 according to arboriculturist plan 24\_5837\_09\_49 dated 27 September 2024.

Your utmost diligence and speedy response would be gratefully received to proceed with felling works as quickly as possible before spring sets in.

These trees were planted and in direct contact with a brick boundary wall and are now causing the wall to crumble with cracks appearing everywhere. Please refer to James Carter's surveyor's report

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.
