

Lime Tree pollard

- 1 – To establish new pollard points below previous pollarding
 - 2 – To reduce the tree's height by 8 meters and its spread by 2-3 meters
 - 3 – To eliminate any basal growth on the trunk
- FOLLOW BLUE LINE for cutting point (RED line was previous pollarding)



The reason for the slightly larger pollarding request is that this tree is very close to the house, and has been allowed to grow so tall due to years of sporadic pruning.

I am now seeking to bring it to the same height as the street limes that are pollarded by Camden on a regular basis.
