The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

## Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed single storey rear extension, by reason of its design, bulk, depth, size, form and siting, would result in an incongruous addition which would erode legibility of the rear façade and result in significant loss of garden space causing harm to the historic and architectural significance of this Grade II listed building and the character and appearance of the Primrose Hill Conservation Area, contrary to Policies D1

(Design) and D2 (Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017, the London Plan 2021 and National Planning Policy Framework 2024.
