The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** listed building consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposed single storey rear extension, by reason of its design, bulk, depth, size, form and siting would result in an incongruous addition which would erode legibility of the rear façade and result in significant loss of garden space causing harm to the historic and architectural significance of this Grade II listed building,

contrary to Policy D2 (Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017, the London Plan 2021 and National Planning Policy Framework 2024.

2 The proposed internal alterations at ground floor level would result in the loss of the surviving plan form causing harm to the historic and architectural significance of this Grade II listed building, contrary to Policy D2 (Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017, the London Plan 2021 and National Planning Policy Framework 2024.
