Proposal:  
(TPO Ref: 8H-T35) REAR GARDEN: 1 x Copper Beech (T006) - Prune back from the building on northern aspect by 2m from branch tips, back to previous pruning points and suitable branch junctions, leaving a finished spread on northern aspect of 4.5m.  
(TPO REF: C511 2005) SIDE GARDEN: 1 x Holm Oak (T007) - Prune back from the building on north-eastern aspect by 1m from branch tips, back to previous pruning points and suitable branch junctions, leaving a finished spread on north-eastern aspect of 1.5m.

The Council has considered your application dated 13 December 2024 and decided to grant consent subject to the following condition(s):

Conditions and Reasons:

- 1 This decision is valid for 2 years from the date of this decision or until the work is completed, whichever is the sooner.

Reason: To allow the Local planning authority to monitor the completion and standards of the work.

- 2 All work shall be carried out in accordance with the relevant recommendations of British Standard 3998: 2010. (Recommendation for Tree Work)

Reason: To ensure the preservation of the amenity value and health of the tree(s).
