The approved planning application, 2014/6588/P, retained the function room and community space on the first floor, but the new stairs was not added, so CAMRA would like to request that the Council insist that this staircase is built to allow access to the function room. The pub has an ACV, which is a material planning consideration, so the council should refuse this application and insist that the stairs be installed to the first floor to the function room.
