I have submitted by strong objection on the Camden website and copy my comment below:

My home Crestview lies in the Dartmouth Park Conservation Area which is primarily residential and we are highly visible from Hampstead Heath and further afield. Such an ugly installation would be completely out of place on this small, residential building and have a harmful effect on the views in the surrounding areas such as Parliament Hill Fields, Hampstead Heath and the Grade II * listed building of St Mary Brookfield (next door). The roofline of our building is almost level with that of the church - anything on our roof would therefore dominate this heritage building and have a negative impact on its setting and that of the conservation area.

The last planning application was refused for the above reasons plus the overwhelming oversized scope of the proposed installation. Nothing has changed in this latest application. In fact there are additional items like railings surrounding the roof perimeter of the lift-housing unit plus gates on the lift-housing roof and a large, hooped CAT ladder descending from the top level down to the main roof. Antenna numbers may have been reduced from 6 short ones (two per mast) - but now they propose 3 long ones (one per mast)
