Proposed Work:

AROUND BOUNDARY OF GROUNDS (SEE MAP): 1 x Birch (Betula utilis) (T5) - Prune low limb to West at around 2.5m, back by around 2m.

- 1 x Lime (Tilia x europea) (T11) Remove epicormic growth from around base of stem.
- 1 x Chestnut (Aesculus hippocastanum) (T1) Prune growth to South to give 1.5m clearance from building.
- 2 x Goat Willow (Salix caprea) (T4) Prune to give 1m clearance from Building. Reduce remaining crown by around 1.5m to maintain best compact form.
- 1 x Cherry (Prunus avium) (T7) Lift crown to give 2.5m ground clearance over footpaths.
- 1 x Ash (Fraxinus sp.) (T14) Reduce lateral growth to E by up to 1.5m, pruning to suitable growth points/branch fork junctions. Reduce and shape

height by up to 1m to best form.

- 1 x Whitebeam (Sorbus aria) (T17) Lift crown to give around 2.5m ground clearance all round.
- 1 x Holm Oak (Quercus ilex) (T18) Prune to give 1m clearance from streetlight. Lift crown to give 5m ground clearance over road and 2.5m clearance over footpaths.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 21 January 2025 and does not wish to object.
