If approval is granted, stringent conditions should be imposed to ensure noise levels remain within acceptable limits, including regular compliance checks and restrictions on operating hours.

Given the residential nature of our area, I suggest to reject this application or, at the very least, impose strict conditions to minimise the impact on residents.
