I live on Parliament Hill and given the geographical characteristics of the area this proposal is at best ill conceived. Parliament Hill, as the name suggests, is on a slope. The soil is predominantly London Clay. There is historical evidence of flooding and subsidence in the area. The houses are close together. All of this means that any excavation work can have a serious impact on nearby houses - something that has happened in the past. In addition, any excavation work can lead to a worsening of the flooding problem in the area. I would also add that this area is very well served by swimming facilities. The pools at Kentish Town and Swiss Cottage are only 10 minutes away by public transport. The Lido and the ponds are within walking distance. So there is no need to apply for an additional swimming pool in this area.
