Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed alterations to the ground floor fenestration by virtue of the cladding of the brick pier in Corten steel, enlargement of the window openings to the front elevation at second and third floor and removal of the balcony at the rear would compromise the architectural unity of the wider building and would result in detrimental harm being caused to the design, form, character and appearance of the host building and the terrace of which it forms a part, contrary to the requirements of policy D1 of the Camden Local Plan 2017.
