This application sets a dangerous precedent for excavation of this kind which not only poses a structural threat to neighbouring properties but also changes the nature of these houses and the area.  Even if the structure under 28 parliament hill is solid, the neighbouring houses will be negatively affected over time due to the shifting clay. We have seen this happen to neighbouring houses to other excavations in parliament hill and south hill park over the past 40 years. Many families have lived in these houses for more than 30years and intend to continue living here. By allowing this application, our houses would be under threat of developments like this which significantly change the nature of the houses in this area and pose a structural threat to neighbouring houses. In addition, this application is unnecessary as there are already three neighbouring swimming pools on the heath.
