Hi,

I would like to register my strong objection to a planning proposals at 10 Adamson Road. The application is **2025/0319/T**.

The proposals are to fell two trees: a Cherry Laurel (T3) and a Portugal Laurel (T2).

Both trees are essential features of the natural environment on Adamson Road, I see squirrels in both trees every day, and birds nesting in both trees every year. They add to the natural beauty of the street, and a critical for privacy between the houses on Eton Avenue and Adamson Rd.

Other trees on the same plot have been subject to TPOs in the past 5 years, which is entirely reasonable, and these trees should be subject to exactly the same protections.

There is absolutely no valid reason to fell trees which have been on the street longer than any of us. This same applicant keeps applying to cut down all the trees on the plot.
