

## **Sequence of Operations:**

All cabling will be carried out in a sensitive nature to take into consideration the sensitivity of working in a listed building environment.

## **Cable Runs:**

- Main pub internal cameras will be run long beams, cornices & ceiling/ wall joints in line with existing cables and stapled to be as inobtrusive as possible.
- Cables can be painted after installation to match existing finishes and to help blend into the environment
- Internal cables will be brought up through the floor to the 1<sup>st</sup> floor office at the earliest convenience to reduce impact
- Cameras will be sited in corners or low visual areas to reduce visual impact and painted after installation to match existing background colours. (as standard cameras only come in two colours grey and black). Where neither colour is suitable a hand painted finish will be provided
- Cable run to the outside will follow existing cable routes along the wall and external beams in black cable to match existing environment and reduce visual impact
- External cables will be brought into the 1<sup>st</sup> floor office through the window frame and finish in the existing comms cabinet.
- All external cable routes will be via existing routes and existing catenary to minimise the impact of additional visible cable.

## **Mounting:**

- Internal cameras to be mounted and installed using 5.5mm Red Rawl plugs or cavity fixings if required for a secure installation in a public area where there is a risk of vandalism.
- Internal camera screws will be 1" ½ 8
- External cameras to be mounted with fixings into mortar only using 5.5mm red Rawl plugs
- External camera screws will be 2" x 10

NVR will be fitted into Customers IT cabinet and then be connected to an HD Monitor via an appropriate HDMI cable.

All cameras and control equipment will be tested and commissioned at the time of installation.

On completion of all works a service report will be produced and signed by the General Manager or responsible person on site.

TELLIVUE operatives will remove all excess materials, tools and equipment and where necessary vacuum the floor and work area to ensure it is clean and tidy before departing the project.
