The extended use of glass balustrading at 255 Goldhurst does not appear to be detailed in the planning permission granted in 2011 for it nor does it appear to be included in the planning permission granted in 2018 for 251 Goldhurst Terrace. Precedents should not be accepted for this application, particularly if they were not in the planning permission for the neighbours. If this aspect of the application is granted there will be a complete lack of regard to the conservation area principles for heritage etc in this area. While not publicly visible Camden's guidance notes do recognise the importance of sympathetic design of rear extensions in properties particularly in conservation areas and, if granted, the guidance notes will be completely undermined.
