**FULL PLANNING & CONSENT TO DISPLAY ADVERTISEMENTS APPLICATIONS
UK-046853 – Kingsway (Opposite Wild Court), London, WC2B 6EX**

We write on behalf of our client, BT Telecommunications Plc, outlining their intention to remove the existing InLink Unit at the above location, and deploy a Street Hub 3 Unit, in its place.

As such, this is a joint submission seeking Full Planning Permission, for the Unit itself, and Express Advertise Consent, to allow the displaying of advertisements relating to the 2no. digital display screens which are incorporated within the Unit.

The application site and the existing InLink Unit are found on adopted highways-controlled land that is maintained at the public expense. BT are a statutory undertaker and can install communications equipment on the adopted highway, hence an owner's notice has been served on the Highways Authority and any others who have been identified from Land Registry records.
