Approx. Height - 16m

Approx. Crown Spread Diameter - 12m

Location - Rear garden Rear boundary left hand corner

Service - Section dismantle and treat

Work Required - Section dismantle as close to trees current ground level as possible and leave the stump in the ground, Treat stump with one application of glyphosate (eco-plugs) only to best endeavour the prevention of regrowth.

Reason - to eliminate the need for continuous maintenance, tree becoming and actionable nuisance with the neighbouring properties and retaining wall

Priority Code - B

PLEASE NOTE. This tree cannot be reduced down any further without being detrimental to the trees health.

Tree Number - T2

Tree Type - Sycamore (Acer psuedoplatanus)

Approx. Diameter at 1.5m - 0.1-0.3m

Approx. Height - 10m

Approx. Crown Spread Diameter - 6m

Location - Rear garden Rear boundary right hand side

Service - crown reduce

Work Required - Crown reduce by removing between 2-3m from the height and between 1-1.5m from the sides

Reason - to control and contain overall size of tree giving closeness to surrounding properties, tree becoming and actionable nuisance with the neighbouring properties and retaining wall

Priority Code - B

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.

- indicate the main features of the site where the tree(s) stand and its surroundings; in particular, you should:
  - o mark and name surrounding roads
  - o sketch in buildings, including adjoining properties
  - o add house numbers or names
- mark the position of the tree(s) to which you want to carry out work and identify them by the number shown in the Tree Preservation Order where possible; if you use a different number, please make sure that this can be matched with your description of the tree(s)
- if there are many trees on the site, make clear which tree(s) are included in this application by:
  - o marking all trees on the plan, but only numbering those to which you want to carry out work
  - showing the approximate distance between the application tree(s) and buildings
  - o adding other relevant features on the site (e.g. greenhouse, paths)

If it is impossible to identify the tree(s) accurately on the plan (e.g. because they are part of a woodland or group of trees), please identify their approximate location on the plan and provide details of how the tree(s) are marked on site (e.g. high visibility tape, tree tags, paint, etc); trees must not be marked by scarring or cutting into the bark.
