

Central Somers Town Community Hall Access plan



Purpose of the Document: A plan setting out a package of measures to be adopted by the owner in providing the local community access to the events space.

Coopers Lane Community Hall

The Coopers Lane Community Hall is located on the ground floor of no 9 Hampden Close. The space forms the ground floor of one of 2 new affordable housing blocks in Somers Town which are being delivered as part of the Somers Town masterplan.

The Hall is owned by Camden Council and managed by the Coopers Lane TRA.

The space will be available for use by Community groups to book within the hours set out below.

The community space and summary of responsibilities:

The community space comprises:

- a community hall
- kitchen
- office
- Toilets
- community garden

The community hall is suitable for meetings, hobbies, classes, and low impact exercise classes such as Yoga and Pilates.

Conditions of use:

Use of the external area and community garden must avoid disturbance of nearby residents.

The general public will not be able to rent/hire the facilities outside of approved opening hours and all use of community facilities will be restricted to the hours of operation.

Bookers must agree to comply with the Regulations Governing Hire of the building and may be asked to supply risk assessments in advance for their activities.
