## Reason(s) for Refusal

The rendering, by reason of the resulting loss of the visibility of the brickwork and the impermeable nature of the rendering is harmful to the historic fabric and special interest of the garden wall and the host building which are grade II\* listed and the character and appearance of the wider Hampstead Conservation Area, contrary to policies D1 (Design) and D2 (Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan and DH2 of the Hampstead Neighbourhood Plan.
