- 1. Inaccurate information: D&A states incorrectly that the property is not in a conservation area. Parkhill and Upper Park Conservation Area Appraisal & Management Strategy identifies No 28 Parkhill Road as a building that makes a positive contribution.
- 2.Discrepancy: Materials: D&A on materials '... joinery will be white painted timberwork.the roof will be a planted green roof" Application form describes roof as EPDM and windows and doors to be UPVC. UPVC unacceptable in conservation area.
- 3. Insufficient detail on proposed foul and surface water drainage: The proposed bathrooms, enlarged terrace and roof will create need for additional foul and surface water disposal. Application form states surface water to soak away and foul drainage proposal "unknown". Unsatisfactory.
