Dear Karolina,

We write following our recent discussions to outline our findings in relation to the front vault.

What appears to be a Loquat tree has grown directly above the masonry vault arch.

As these trees can grow up to 8m tall it's very possible that this will destabilise the arch over time.

It's also possible that in taking away the tree we might find some of the roots have become integral and the arch needs to be replaced as a result.

In order to guarantee an extension to the design life of the vault, the tree should be removed, and then the arch repaired/strengthened if needed.
