2.1 Site Location and Description





Figure 1: Site Plan

The building is a ten-storey property which holds residential flats located in West Hampstead, Camden and exclusively holds residential apartments, with the majority of the buildings holding a balcony with a shaded area. The apartment which we intend to add the canopy does not have a shaded area unlike the other apartments in this building.

2.2 The Brief and Design Process

The building is a single-use space comprising of only residential units.

The proposal will only have one external elements, however these amendments will be structurally minimal. As well as this, the external amendments will adhere to policy 7.6 of the London Plan (2016) ensuring that nearby residential buildings will not loose privacy.




