Despite this the developer seems to have further ignored community sentiment and has proposed to make the development even taller than the prior plans.</p> <p>The latest proposals make the development far too tall for the area. Camden Council must reject the development proposal in its current form and force the developer to produce plans that are more fitting with the wider area - namely, the buildings must be a much lower height than the current plans.</p>

I object because of their height and the grotesque blight of the local area.</p> <p>The updated plans add two storeys to three of the tallest blocks in Phase 1, and extra storeys to five other blocks. This takes the tallest block to 17 storeys, with two 16 storey blocks. The tallest block is now over four metres higher than previously approved. This is even more out of keeping with the local area.</p>
