The tree will be accessed by means of an aerial climber with an aerial rescue operative in attendance and a ground crew.. the climber will reduce back the tree removing the growth that has been achieved since it was last pollarded. The Lime tree is highlighted on the scribble map plan submitted on this application. You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.
