The developers are proposing that in the final development there would be a total of just 2,500sqm of supermarket space. This is totally inadequate especially considering that the development will result in up to 6,000 new residents. The application itself sets out the strength of feeling over the loss of the large Sainsburys and yet the developers have chosen to totally ignore this community feedback. We see time and again new developments in London with the provision of completely inadequate mini supermarkets.
